

Collaborative Partnership Agreement between the Community College of Allegheny County and Pennsylvania College of Technology

Pathway from AS in Electrical Construction to BS in Applied Management

The Community College of Allegheny County (CCAC), in partnership with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), offers a five-year Associate of Science degree program in Electrical Construction. This collaborative apprenticeship program/partnership provides students an ideal learning environment that includes the demands of academic coursework with direct and relevant industry experience.

Pennsylvania College of Technology (Penn College) is excited to partner with CCAC and IBEW to further enhance the education of their Electrical Construction graduates by offering these graduates a direct and convenient pathway to a Bachelor of Science degree in Applied Management.

Students who successfully meet the rigorous demands of the CCAC/IBEW program and earn an Associate of Science degree in Electrical Construction, will automatically be able to directly transfer 60 or 61 of their earned credits toward the Penn College, Bachelor of Science Applied Management degree. The CCAC Electrical Construction graduates will have the option to complete all remaining coursework online.

Per transfer policy, of the remaining 59 or 60 credits required to earn this Bachelor of Science degree, at least 36 must be completed through Penn College coursework. CCAC Electrical Construction graduates will work closely with an adviser or administrator from the Penn College School of Business & Hospitality to ensure at least 60 or 61 credits earned through CCAC/IBEW program transfer appropriately.

This agreement represents a collaborative and lasting relationship and shall become effective upon the signature of both parties. This agreement will be active for five calendar years, but may be terminated by either party with written notice of intent to do so, provided at least three months in advance. This agreement supersedes all previous agreements and revisions must be in writing and acknowledged by both parties.
