EMERGENCY RESPONDER

This 52 hour American Red Cross program is designed to train those individuals who have a duty to respond in emergency situations (FIRST RESPONDERS) with the knowledge and skills necessary to help sustain life, reduce pain and minimize the consequences of injury or sudden illness until advanced medical help arrives. This course includes CPR for the Professional Rescuer, specialized skills and techniques used by those individuals who have a duty to respond in emergency situations. It is highly recommended for police, fire, emergency squad, camp staff and workplace rapid response personnel.

EMT-BASIC

This 152 hour course covers all techniques of emergency medical care presently considered within the responsibilities of the EMT, as well as operational aspects of the job, which they will be expected to perform. This program follows the National Standard Curriculum as adopted by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Topics covered include an overview of the EMT's job, a description of the training course, and an overview of anatomy and physiology. Included in this program are lessons on life threatening emergencies, muscular skeletal injuries, common medical emergencies, childbirth and problems of pediatric patients, lifting and moving patients, environmental emergencies, extrication from automobiles, and operation aspects of the EMT's job. Each lesson provides for practice of the skills taught in that lesson. The course also includes a final written exam of knowledge and a final practical evaluation of skills. Students must be 16 years of age at first class session
