Individuals with a degree in Ethnic and Diversity Studies can be found working in a variety of fields, including education, human resources management, marketing and social services.

An associate's degree in Ethnic and Diversity Studies can prepare students to enroll in a four-year institution and earn degrees in a wide variety of disciplines, including pre-law, pre-medicine, political science and sociology. There is not an articulation agreement in place at this time with any four-year colleges and universities, so please check with a transfer counselor to confirm that credits earned are transferable.

The Ethnic and Diversity Studies program is multidisciplinary and draws from a broad range of academic areas of study, including history, psychology, anthropology, sociology and religious studies.

Students who complete this degree will be able to think and write critically about race, class and ethnicity in a social and historical context, exhibit an understanding of ethnic and diversity studies from an interdisciplinary approach, distinguish among the experiences of a variety of diverse cultures and provide an analytic framework that facilitates awareness of how cultures vary and shape the human experience.
