



Top Ten Reasons to Love Assessment...

- 1. Faculty get essential feedback as to what is and what isn't working in the classroom**
- 2. Assessment results form the basis of how to improve curriculum and teaching/learning strategies to further improve learning.**
- 3. Assessment activities can bring faculty together (♥) to discuss important issues such as what to teach and why and to establish standards and expectations.**
- 4. Assessment activities help faculty see how their courses link to programs and how what they teach benefits students in subsequent pursuits.**
- 5. Assessment results allow students and faculty to identify strengths and weakness and to make improvements from there.**
- 6. Assessment clarifies faculty expectations to students and helps them understand where they should focus their time and energies.**
- 7. Assessment helps students understand their own roles and responsibilities in achieving stated learning goals.**
- 8. Assessment can help insure that institutional resources are being used in the most effective ways – where they will have greatest impact on student learning!**
- 9. Assessment results can become a very meaningful part of the Program Review Process and help form recommendations that come out of that process.**
