If you are using a typewriter instead of a word-processing program, underline the text to be italicized.

Book by One Author

Schein, J. R. (1993). *The consumer's guide to drug interactions*. New York: Collier.

Book with Multiple Editors

Bringmann, W. G., Luck, H. E., Miller, R., & Early, C. E. (Eds.). (1997). *A pictorial history of psychology*. Chicago: Quintessence.

Note: Use et al. when there are 7 or more authors or editors.

Book with No Author/Editor

Random House Webster's college dictionary (2nd ed.). (1997). New York: Random House.

A Dictionary or Encyclopedia

Runco, M. A., et. al. (Eds.). (1999). *Encyclopedia of Creativity*. San Diego: Academic Press.

Note: Use et al. when there are 7 or more authors or editors.

Article from a Monthly Magazine

Vesilind, P. J. (2000, May). In search of Vikings. *National Geographic*, 197, 2-35.

Note: "197" refers to the volume number

Article from a Weekly Magazine

Labi, N. (2000, May 1). Requiem for a Dauphin. *Time*, 155, 62.

Newspaper Article

Donnan, S. (2000, April 28). Legendary Fiji rabble-rouser a diplomat now. *The Christian Science Monitor*, pp. 7, 8.

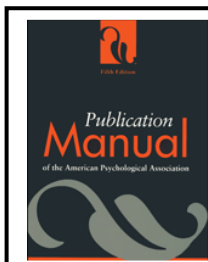
Journal Article (one author)

Frohnsdorff, G. (1999). Facts? of Publication: Cataloging problems posed by deceptive information. *Library Resources & Technical Services*, 43, 213-222.

Journal Article (multiple authors)

Waldhart, T. J., Miller, J. B., & Chan, L. M. (2000). Provision of local assisted access to selected Internet information resources by ARL academic libraries. *Journal of Academic Librarianship*, 26(2), 100-109.

Notes: Use et al. when there are 7 or more authors or editors.
Volume number, 26, is italicized but the issue number, (2), is not.
