Articulation Agreement

Associate in Science in Art to the **Bachelor of Science in Fine Arts**

Community College of Allegheny County and Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania

This articulation agreement is built on the foundation of a long-standing, professional relationship between *Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania (SRU)* and the *Community College of Allegheny County (CCAC)*. SRU enters into this agreement with CCAC as demonstration of this relationship and of the University's commitment to providing quality educational opportunities for community college students. Based on this written agreement and the voluntary, cooperative efforts of both institutions, CCAC graduates of the *Associate in Science in Art* degree will be ensured a smooth transfer and timely completion of the *Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art* major at Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania.

I. Purpose

The purpose of this written agreement is to outline the terms and conditions of the articulation between the CCAC *Associate in Science in Art* and the *Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art* major at SRU. The agreement also denotes the transfer policies, services provided, and information available to students who have earned college credits from CCAC and plan to transfer to SRU.

II. Terms and Conditions of the Agreement

- 1.) CCAC students, who have earned an Associate in Science in Art, are guaranteed admission to SRU and to the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art major, if they have earned a minimum GPA of 2.0 and are in good academic standing at all institutions attended.
- 2.) CCAC Associate in Science in Art degree holders, who have followed the articulation curriculum planner, are guaranteed that all of their associate degree course-work will be accepted to the university and applied to the SRU Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art major to a maximum of 67 credits.
- 3.) Transfer credit will be awarded for all completed associate degree, non-developmental course-work, for which a letter grade of "C" or greater is earned for art-related coursework and a letter grade of "D" or greater is earned for general education and free elective coursework.
- 4.) SRU will provide an *unofficial* audit of transferable credits prior to application to the University upon the student's request.
- 5.) At the time of evaluation of an admission application, SRU will provide an *official* audit of the student's transferable credits to the University.
- 6.) Upon acceptance of the University's offer of admission and payment of the admission deposit, the student will receive an *official* audit of all completed transferable credits into his/her chosen major.
- 7.) Students who accept SRU's offer of admission, prior to the beginning of the advanced registration period, will be assigned an academic advisor and a registration date commensurate with SRU students who have earned the same number of credits.

III. Responsibilities of the Parties of this Agreement

- 1.) SRU and CCAC will work cooperatively to support and effectively administer this articulation agreement in the best interest of the students.
- 2.) SRU and CCAC will regularly communicate regarding changes in transfer policies and procedures, curriculum requirements, and any other relevant issues and/or concerns.
- 3.) CCAC agrees to provide information to its students regarding the SRU Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art and all other majors and services available at SRU.
- 4.) The SRU Coordinator of Transfer Services agrees to annually visit CCAC to meet with students who plan to transfer to SRU.

IV. Agreement Certification


This agreement is in effect on the date of official signature by both institutions and will be updated annually and reviewed for renewal.



** CCAC students should take a minimum of three (3) credits or one (1) course in Dance, Music or Theater. SRU recommends Music or Theater, as indicated above.

This curriculum planner was compiled by SRU to demonstrate how the Associate in Science in Art transfers to the University's Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art degree. It should not replace the associate degree curriculum planner issued by CCAC, but instead may be a supplement to the CCAC planner, for those students interested in transferring to SRU. Students should be aware that if curriculum requirements change, they would be responsible for requirements at the time of enrollment at SRU.
