

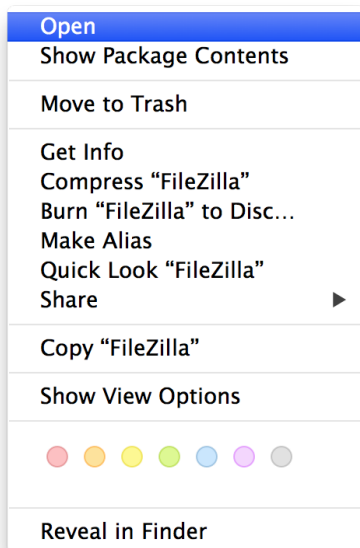
## Publishing Academic Webpages using Filezilla on a Mac

Download and install Filezilla from <https://filezilla-project.org/>

After launching FileZilla you might see a message from Gatekeeper, a security feature built into Mac OS X, stating the application cannot be opened.



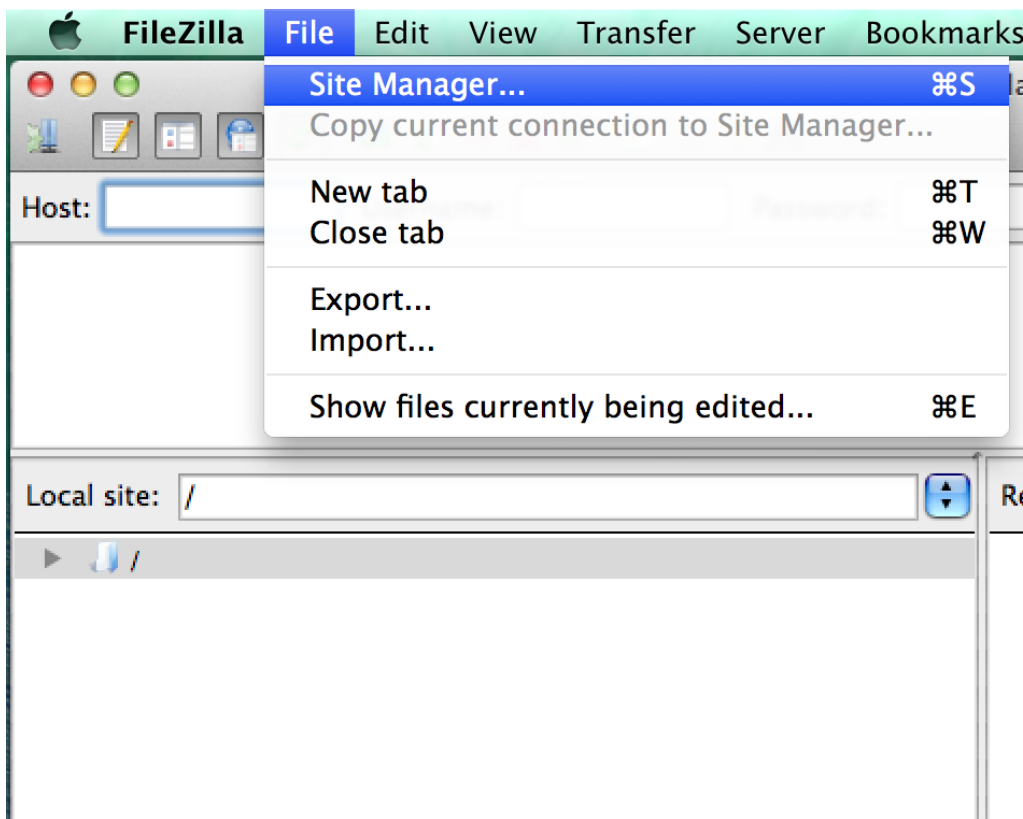
If that is the case you should double click on the Application and choose Open.



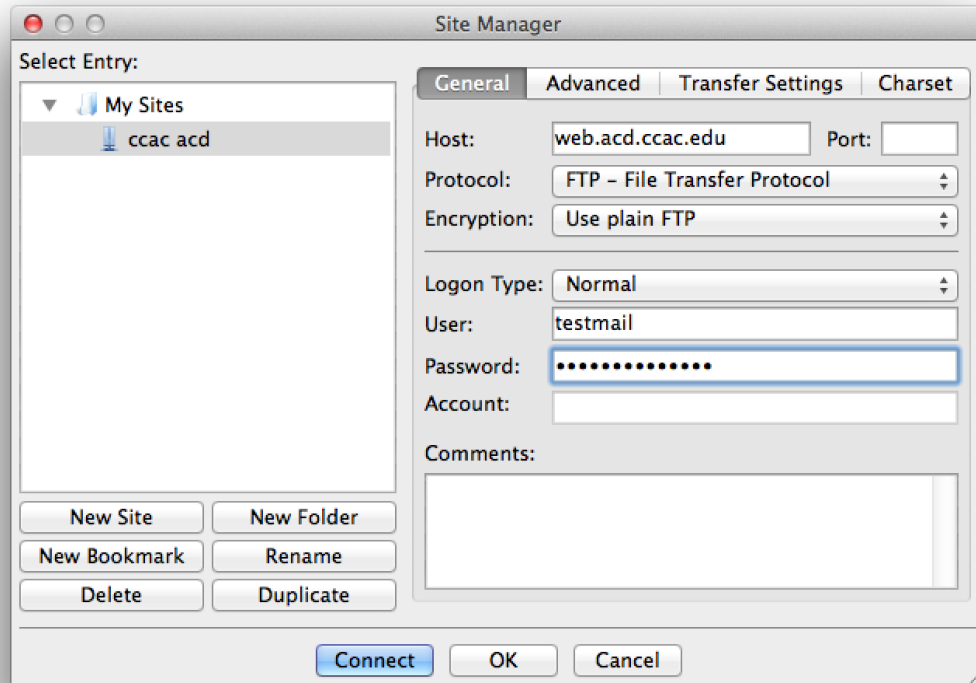
After selecting open, Gatekeeper should now allow you to open the application.



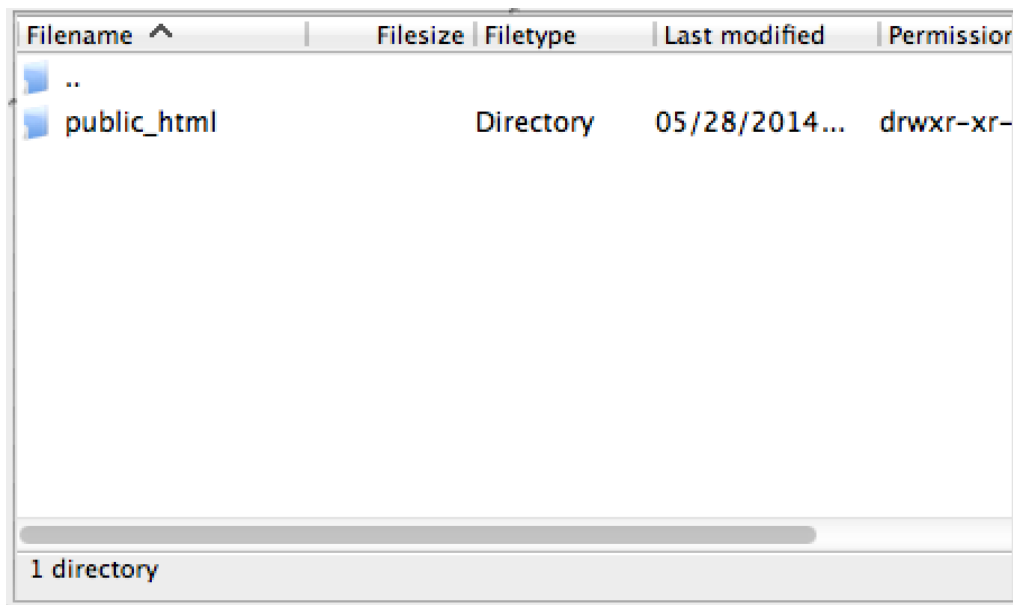
Open FileZilla is started, click on **File** and then **Site Manager...**



In Site Manager create a **New Site**. Give the site a name and under the General tab enter **web.acd.ccac.edu** into the **Host** field, change the **Logon Type** to **Normal**, enter your CCAC NetID into **User**, and your NetID password into **Password**. Click on **Connect**.



Once connected double click on public\_html on the **Remote Site** to enter the public\_html directory.



On the **Local Site** choose the directory on your Mac where you keep the files you wish to publish. To upload files drag and drop the files from the **Local Site** to the **Remote Site**.
